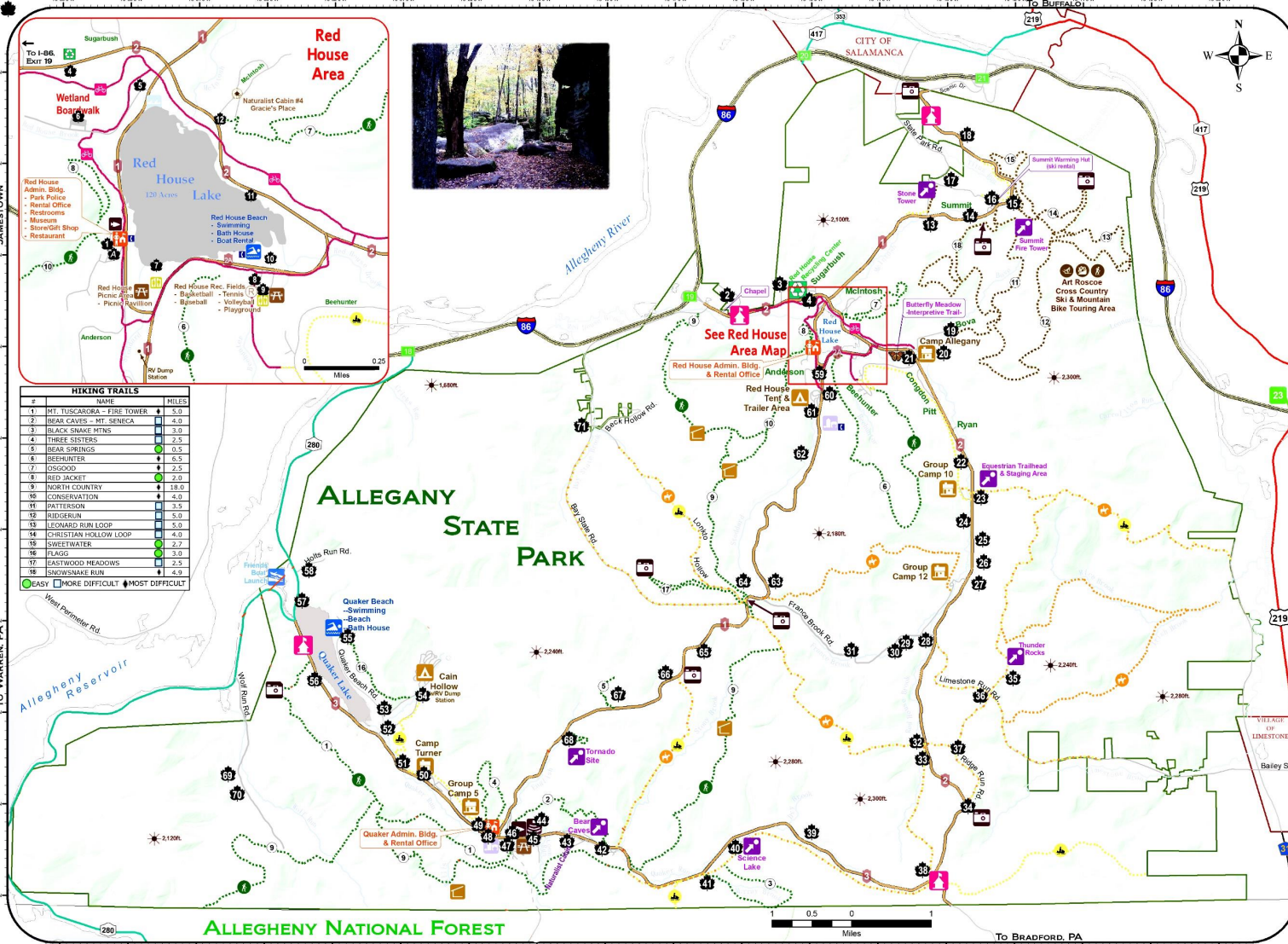


ASP SITE LOCATION MAP



- Commonly used program sites.
- Site A - Red House Administration Building, lower lobby, patio, or museum as indicated.
 - Site 1 - Red Jacket Nature Trail: Meet on stairs across from administration building.
 - Site 4 - Meet across from Red House recycling center.
 - Site 5 - Meet on maintenance/access road near the intersection of Rt. 1 and 2.
 - Site 6 - Meet at Red House wetland parking lot.
 - Site 7 - Meet at stone pier in Red House picnic area.
 - Site 9 - Meet at Beehunter picnic shelter.
 - Site 11 - Meet directly across Red House Lake from the Administration building.
 - Site 12 - Meet at entrance to Macintosh Cabin trail.
 - Site 15 - Meet at entrance to Art Roscoe Cross Country Ski Trails.
 - Site 16 - Meet at Summit Warming hut.
 - Site 19 - Meet at Bova Ski Area parking lot at the end of the side road past Camp Allegheny.
 - Site 29 - Meet at the second bridge on France Brook Rd.
 - Site 35 - Meet at Thunder Rocks
 - Site 40 - Meet at Science Lake parking lot.
 - Site 41 - Meet at Black Snake Mountain Trail
 - Site 42 - Meet at East entrance to the Bear Caves trail between Parallel and Kaiser Cabin Trails
 - Site 43 - Naturalist Cabin - located right across from Buffalo facility building between Fancher Cottages and Parallel Cabin trail.
 - Site 44 - Meet at Quaker Amphitheater
 - Site 45 - Meet at Quaker Picnic Area
 - Site 49 - Meet near at the bridge towards athletic field its parking lot is next to Quaker General Store.
 - Site 53 - Meet on the Quaker Beach Rd. at the gate near the Osprey platform.
 - Site 62 - Meet at Bridal Falls parking lot on ASP Rt. 1
 - Site 64 - Meet on ASP Rt. 1 at the Eastwood Meadows parking lot.
 - Site 67 - Meet at Bear Springs
 - Site 68 - Meet at the Tornado Blowdown Interpretive Area
 - Butterfly Meadow - Meet across from the Camp Allegheny entrance road on ASP Rt. 2
 - Macintosh Naturalist Cabin - meet Macintosh Cabin Trail at Macintosh Cabin #4 (Gracie's Place).
 - Quaker Spillway - Meet at parking lot right next to the Quaker Dam
